

A Scout's Responsibility To "Be Prepared"

Board of Review

- ♦ Successfully complete a Scoutmasters Conference. (see "A Scouts Responsibility to Be Prepared" for the Scoutmaster Conference).
- ♦ Notify the Advancement Chairperson that you have completed the Scoutmaster Conference and that you would like a Board of Review.
- Be prepared for the Board of Review
 - ◆ Wear your full field dress uniform (this includes BSA approved shirt, neckerchief, belt, pants, and socks).
 - Bring along an accurate copy of your Advancement printout that was checked for accuracy against your Scout Handbook, advancement cards, and merit badge cards.
 - ♦ Be prepared to discuss your rank requirements
 - Why did you like a particular requirement?
 - Which requirement did you feel was most important and why?
 - ♦ Which requirement(s) did you learn the most from? (Note: This is not a technical review, but rather a review where your thoughts and feelings are important).
 - ♦ Know your goals in Scouting and be prepared to discuss them. What are your Leadership interests?
 - ◆ Discuss suggestions for Troop activities and what things you would like to see more of and less of.
 - ♦ Be prepared to discuss how you have demonstrated Scout Spirit by living the Scout Oath and Scout Law in your everyday life.
